Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above planning application relating to the demolition of two buildings in the Riverside conservation area to make way for a small housing development.

While the Forth & Borders Cases Panel of the Architectural Heritage Society of Scotland (AHSS) considers the existing buildings to have little historical merit, we feel consent for demolition should not be granted until such time as a suitable proposal for their replacement has been approved.

We note that The Scottish Executive Guide to Conservation Areas in Scotland (2005) states that any application to demolish a building in a conservation area requires 'detailed plans of existing <u>and replacement</u> buildings'. We therefore object to this proposal on the grounds that, at present, it contravenes this advice.
