Public Meeting: 7.30pm on Monday 25 November, 2019 in
Ayr Town Hall. Doors open 7:00pm.

We have invited conservationists politicians and NetworkRail to speak. It is a political decision as to whether we save the hotel or build a new glass and steel station which would cost the government £20m (add demolition at £4m+) with more costs, disruption and loss to our urban environment.

The prospects for the development of tourism are better with a grand Victorian station, particularly if we want to keep the occasional steam excursion coming. It is likely to be a cheaper option anyway.
