**Planning Application Nos: 20/01208/LBA & 20/01291/FUL Flat 0/1, 14 Kirklee Terrace**

The Society has considered the application above and wishes to object to materials proposed for the new gate.

Kirklee Terrace, its lane and mews together make up a unique A-listed enclave in Glasgow's West End. Previous applications to make alterations to this property (19/00228/FUL & 19/00229/LBA) were refused for various reasons, most of which are irrelevant to the current application.

However, it was found that the proposed gate in the previous proposals to be "contrary to Policy in terms of the scale and materials" (our underlining). While the current proposal, in terms of scale, will make no alterations to the existing opening in the wall, it utilises the same materials as having already been refused.

In order to preserve the architectural integrity and character of this important collection of buildings and their associated boundary walls, a timber gate would be the only appropriate choice.
