Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above planning application. The proposals are for the installation of letter plate, sign and intercom to entrance door. The North East Fife Cases Panel of the AHSS has considered the proposal and wishes to make the following comments.

The Architectural Heritage Society of Scotland recommends placing the brass sign on the opposite leaf of the door from the letter plate to create a more balanced layout. It would have the added advantage of reducing damage to the stonework around the doorway.
