Planning Application No: 25/00317/FUL 17 Bellshaugh Road

The Society has examined the application above and wishes to object strongly to the proposed raising of the roof level of this Victorian villa that sits in a prominent corner position within the Glasgow West Conservation Area.

Such an intervention would be contrary to CDP, SG9, paras 2.14, 2.17 & 2.43 and, by radically altering the original design/proportions of the Victorian villa, would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the Conservation Area.

For similar reasons, we object to the proposed dormer window that would be visible from Bellshaugh Road and Bellshaugh Lane; this would be contrary to SG9, paras 2.46 & 2.47.
